

Form 8050-1 Aircraft Registration Application

Here are a few tips to help you fill out the registration form correctly. Remember, how you fill out this form sets in stone who the builder is, what your aircraft is called and what the model is. The builder, model and serial number on this form will be sent back to you on the registration certificate. What is on the registration certificate must match EXACTLY what goes on the Form 8030-6d application for airworthiness certificate AND the data plate that goes on your plane. If they don't match EXACTLY then the airworthiness certificate can't be issued until the data plate is corrected. Your name is last name first for the builder and name of applicant. Where you sign the form on the bottom should be normal.

If you got your aircraft already built from a manufacturer their name can be the aircraft manufacturer. Otherwise who ever actually bolted it together is the aircraft manufacturer, not the kit maker.

If you have a reserved number write it in, if not leave blank →
 The Kit Mfg. who made the parts and the model of kit →
 The serial number you want to use, can be any unique number →

Keep your name consistent, last name first. The name on this application should match all the other FAA forms EXACTLY! →

Address Must be a physical address. PO boxes are not acceptable →

You must print your name under your signature →
